The study found that education disruptions caused by the COVID-19 pandemic had little impact on the anxiety levels of teenagers with autism.

While previous research has shown that the pandemic adversely impacted the overall mental health of adolescents, Kouros' study found that those experiencing mental health difficulties were likely already struggling before March 2020, and teenagers with autism had anxiety levels that remained consistent during pandemic education disruptions, regardless of delivery mode (i.e. in-person, remote or homeschooled).
